- 6. The planned format of the workshop, including a strategy to facilitate lively and interactive discussions.
- 7. A description of the past editions of the workshop if applicable, including website address, and statistics of submitted/accepted papers and attendee numbers. If the workshop does not have past editions, please provide estimates and explain a strategy on how to reach the targets of paper submissions and attendees.
- 8. Publicity and advertising plan to attract paper submissions and attendees.
- 9. A draft of 1-page "Call for Papers (CFP)" including title, description, topics and important dates.
